Thank you for your interest in a needs-based scholarship application. The UJA Federation of Northern New Jersey, through the Israel Programs Center, has made this scholarship available in order to encourage participation in Israel Experience Programs. This scholarship offers financial assistance for teens wishing to go on an Israel Experience. The amount awarded varies, based on the needs of each individual family and is subject to review by the Scholarship Committee of the Israel Programs Center.

Any student living in the Federation catchment area is eligible for this scholarship. Scholarship awards will be paid directly to the program vendor.

*In order to apply, complete and return the application, along with a one page essay explaining why you want to participate in the Israel Experience you have chosen. In order for your application to be processed, this office must receive a copy of the most recent 1040 form (can be from last year) as well as **two** letters of recommendation. Your Rabbi, principal, teacher, camp counselor, etc. are all acceptable sources for recommendations.*

The deadline for this application is February 27, 2009. However, it is recommended that you apply as soon as possible. Since a limited number of scholarships are available, applications will be considered on a first come first served basis. Viable applicants will be interviewed by the committee.
